SAFETY ADVISOR

Reporting to the Safety Supervisor, the Safety Advisor provides support to supervisor, foremen and workers in the field coordination of the day-to-day safety requirements of the assigned project.

Description and Job Duties:

- Maintain a visible presence in the field to promote a safe work environment for all employees, contractors, and visitors.
- Understand and follow Valard's Health, Safety & Environmental (HS&E) Manual.
- Support supervisors and foremen in investigating incidents, identifying root causes, and implementing corrective actions.
- Participate in safety meetings to discuss issues, trends, and upcoming activities; communicate key points to the Project Manager and Supervisors.
- Review daily tailboards to ensure hazards are identified and controlled; provide feedback to workers and ensure JSAs are completed and available on-site.
- Conduct safety observations, inspections, and emergency drills; share findings in meetings and postings.
- Lead weekly safety meetings, record minutes, and prepare weekly/monthly reports.
- Maintain and update safety records, including policies, procedures, training, incidents, and certifications.
- Assist with safety audits, inspections, regulatory reporting, and new employee orientations.
- Coordinate with external safety consultants, inspectors, and vendors.
- Perform other duties as assigned.

Preferred Skills / Qualifications

- Post-secondary education in a related field is an asset.
- 3+ years of safety or construction experience is an asset.
- Equivalent education and experience may be considered.
- Willing to obtain National Construction Safety Officer (NCSO) certification.
- Proficient with Microsoft Office.
- Valid driver's license and clean driver's abstract required.
- Strong organization and communication skills.
- Detail-oriented with good time management and problem-solving skills.
- Able to work independently and as part of a team in a fast-paced environment.
