Plants will be supplied by Seeds for Conservation, a Lakehead Region Conservation Authority program sustainably harvesting seeds native to Northwestern Ontario from our Conservation Areas. Seeds for Conservation contributes to local biodiversity and resilient seed banks by being intentional about species selection, preserving and supporting local genetics and adaptation within our ecosystems.



Native plants provide multiple benefits to our community, including wildlife habitat, food for pollinators, promoting soil health, and filtering air and water.

Plants purchased from Seeds for Conservation have adapted to local conditions, supporting their resiliency in the environment and requiring less maintenance compared to introduced plant species.

The Lakehead Region Conservation Authority's Seeds for Conservation program sustainably harvests seeds native to Northwestern Ontario from our Conservation Areas. The program produces locally sourced, native plants for restoration projects within the Lakehead Watershed, ranging from riparian revegetation, wetland creation, to meadow landscapes. Seeds for Conservation contributes to local biodiversity and resilient seed banks by being intentional about species selection, preserving and supporting local genetics and adaptation within our ecosystems.

Seeds for Conservation plants are adapted to local conditions, increasing perennial success and requiring less maintenance compared to introduced plant species.

Ethical seed harvesting practices are necessary for sustainability, as wild native plants must be given the opportunity to contribute to seed banks in their natural environment for:

- the regeneration and preservation of the plant species
- wildlife including pollinators, birds and mammals which have co-evolved with these plants for millennia and depend on them for food, reproduction and shelter
- the ongoing success of Seeds for Conservation encouraging robust and healthy plant stands for continued harvesting.
